

SkillsUSA - Area VI Pin Contest  
2011-2012

Area VI SkillsUSA is sponsoring its annual Pin Design contest. The winning design will be used for this year's Area VI SkillsUSA Long Island Pin Design Contest. This is an excellent opportunity for you, the SkillsUSA Area VI member to receive recognition because the pin will be mass produced and available at the next Area VI Conference. All secondary student members of SkillsUSA are eligible competitors. The guidelines are strictly enforced and include:

1. Entrant(s) must be a regional (Area VI) SkillsUSA registered secondary member. The design may be a combined effort of more than one student from the same school.
2. Entrant(s) name(s), school, school address, occupational subject, teacher and club advisor's name must be printed or typed on the on the reverse side of the artwork, NOT ON THE FRONT. Copy to be used is attached.

3. Pin design requirements:

- Must be two to four colors - EXACT COLORS MUST BE LABELED USING PANTONE COLORS (see sample). EACH color must be outlined with GOLD to distinguish color separation. GOLD is not counted as one of the colors. (It's a "bonus" color").
  - Must contain Area VI (NOT THE NUMBER 6). (Long Island is Optional)
  - Must contain SkillsUSA (NOTE: Capital underlined letters in SkillsUSA).
  - Must display the year ('11 or 2011).
  - Must be submitted on paper no larger than 8 1/2" x 11". (Size will be reduced to 1" at its widest point for production). DO NOT MOUNT.
  - \*Must include a 6" X 6" copy and a reduced copy to the 1" size (same page).
  - \*Must include a color pallet with pantone colors displayed.
  - Must follow guidelines prescribed by C. Sander's Emblem (attached).
- All Advisors must have access to submit WINNERS file in electronic format if requested: (EPS or PDF format).

4. Artwork will not be returned.
5. Judges' decision is final. All rules must be followed to be eligible.
6. Entries must be received by December 9, 2011.

# SAMPLE: Guidelines for C. Sander's Emblem Use and Label Pantone Colors



6" x 6"

The gold represents the metal border and MUST surround the entire emblem

Small letters and minute detail cannot be made in color. They MUST show as metal.





1" x 1"

Large letters can show in color only if there is room around each letter for the metal wall.

Metal lines (retaining walls) are always necessary to separate one color from another.
