SkillsUSA Advisor of the Year Rules

Criteria

This award will be presented to secondary educators involved in Trade, Industrial, Technical, or Health Occupations courses, and who have achieved prominence at local, state or national levels. One such award will be presented annually.

Eligibility

Individuals who are currently employed as secondary, full-time classroom/laboratory/ and/or co-op coordinators in a vocational-technical education program are eligible for this award. Nominees must be classroom/laboratory teachers at the time of selection.

Contributions and achievements on which the nomination is based should have been made within the past ten years. The nominee must be a paid professional member of SkillsUSA.

SkillsUSA New York ADVISOR OF THE YEAR

Attached you will find the necessary materials and directions to begin the process of selecting – **SkillsUSA New York ADVISOR OF THE YEAR**. (Note: the directions follow the same process that will be utilized by National SkillsUSA ADVISOR OF THE YEAR.)

- Step #1** Any number of secondary Advisors may be submitted from each area of the state. The person nominating must be from the same Area of the State as the nominee. The enclosed directions and formal **NOMINATION FORM** must be adhered to **EXACTLY**.
- Step #2** Send all the paperwork of your Area Nominees to the office of State Coordinator by **January 18, 2008**.

- Step #3** All area nominations received will be given to the Administrator Trustee of another area to select the “Advisor of the Year” from each area. This selection will

take place at the Spring Planning Conference. (NOTE: NO AREA will select their own Advisor of the Year.)

Step #4 Each Advisor selected will be notified three weeks prior to the SkillsUSA New York State Leadership Conference. They will be invited to attend the SkillsUSA New York State Leadership Conference for recognition by their peers and SkillsUSA New York.

Step# 5 The formal and original NOMINATION FORM of each area Advisor of the Year will be submitted to a Selection Committee. This official committee will designate the:

SkillsUSA New York ADVISOR OF THE YEAR

The announcement will be made at the SkillsUSA New York Leadership Conference and NYS Skills Championships. The recipient shall represent NYS for the NATIONAL SkillsUSA ADVISOR OF THE YEAR.
