**NOTE:** Ensure Security Students are **FIRST** to eat all meals so that they will have time for an **early meeting and should be transported by your school before the arrival of other students.** A "*Certificate of Achievement*" for each student will be presented at the conclusion of this event.

Please note and explain to the students that the assignment received is scheduled by the Chairpersons and reflects the needs of the SkillsUSA New York Leadership Conference and Skills Championships. Students will be required to **work during ALL SkillsUSA activities.** Please ensure that they fully understand this responsibility.

**We need the attached form completed and returned to SkillsUSA AND Me by no later than March 20th.** This will allow planning packages to be completed, mailed and reviewed with the student prior to the conference date. Names submitted must be identical to the students attending this conference.
